

**LICENSURE TESTING REQUIREMENTS CHANGES FOR
ELEMENTARY
&
SPECIAL EDUCATION/GENERAL CURRICULUM CANDIDATES**

1. You now have **two options** for the required Math Test for licensure in Elementary Education or Special Education General Curriculum. You must now pass **either** the **Pearson Test 203 Mathematics Subtest** (this is the one which has been currently used- a score of 227 or higher) or the **Praxis Test 7803 – CKT Math Subtest** (This is a brand new test - a score of 150 or higher.) Effective April 6, passing scores on either test will be acceptable for the math subtest licensure requirement.
2. **The Pearson Test 103 – Multisubject Subtest is no longer a requirement for an elementary education or EC-GC license.**
3. The Pearson Test 090 – Foundations of Reading with a score of 229 or higher (this requirement remains the same).
