A BILL TO BE ENTITLED: Request for Psychology Conference Funds

An act to provide for the SGA of HPU to provide funding for Psi Chi in the amount of \$6888.00 to assist with the cost of Society for Personality & Social Psychology on 2/13 - 2/16. Providing for a repeal of all conflicting laws and a savings clause, providing for an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Student Government Association of High Point University:

Section 1: Psi Chi, the International Honor Society for Psychology, organizes many academically-oriented and social events annually and strives to encourage, stimulate, and maintain excellence in scholarship for the members.

Section 2: We are taking a group of 9 students to a national research conference for the Society for Personality and Social Psychology. While there, the students will attend talks, learn about current research, learn about graduate school opportunities, and network with professionals in the field.

Section 3: The conference is in Austin, TX, which is over 1,200 miles from High Point. Therefore, we will be flying.

Section 4: We intend to use multiple sources of funding for this trip. In addition to that requested from SGA (which we appreciate), the psychology department will also be contributing \$1,000, and the 9 students are each paying \$300 plus all of their own food. Advisor is Dr. Chris Lootens, also attending.
