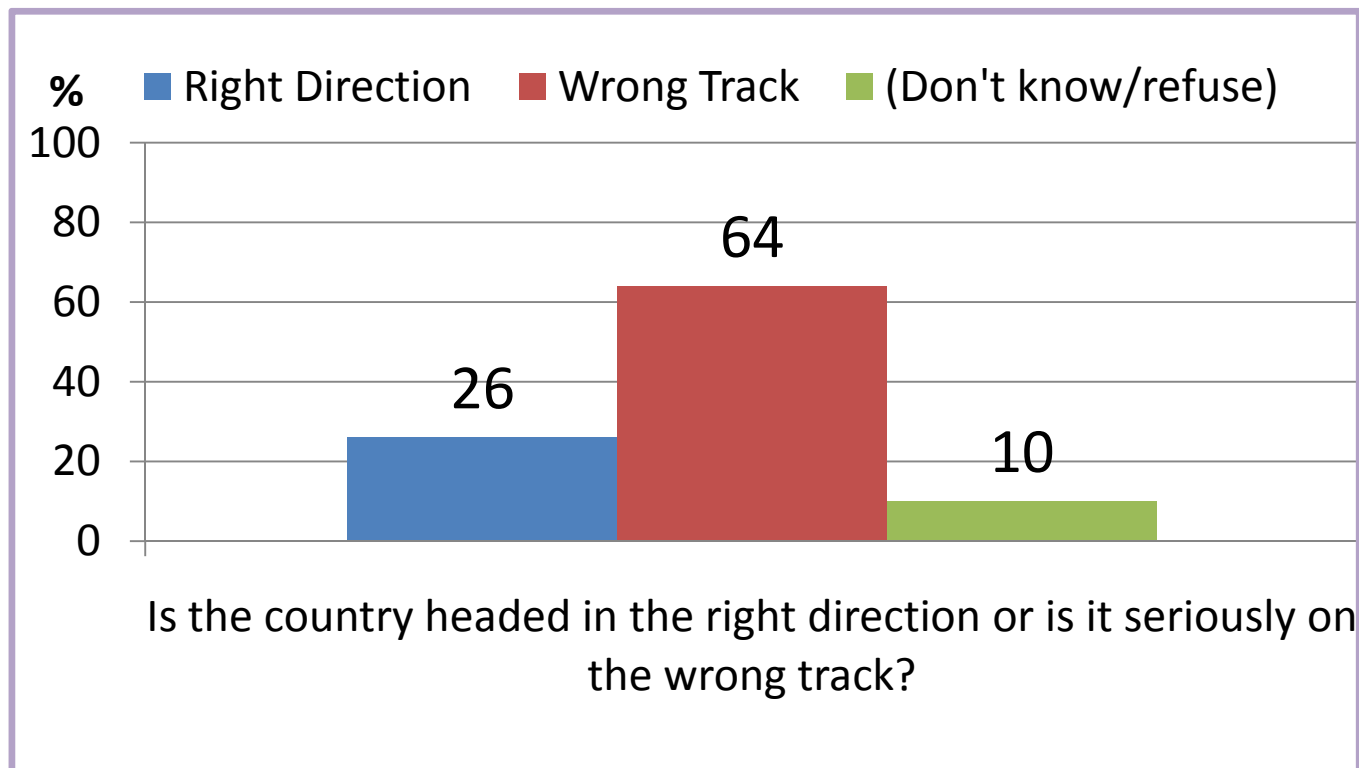

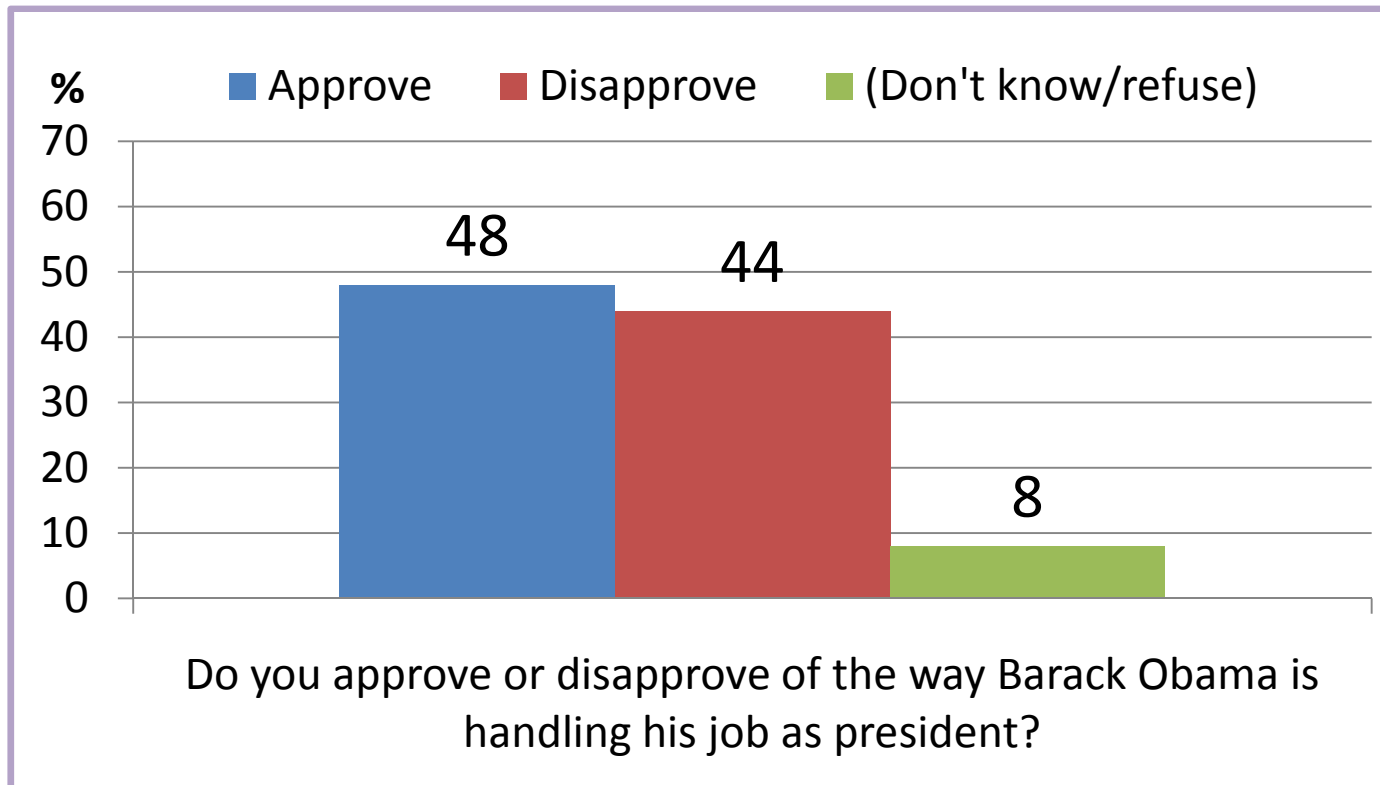
# METHODOLOGY

- 450 Adults (age 18 and older) in North Carolina
- The survey was conducted January 31 – February 3
- The sample is weighted to Census estimates of demographics of North Carolina's population
- Estimated margin of sampling error is plus or minus 4.7 percent

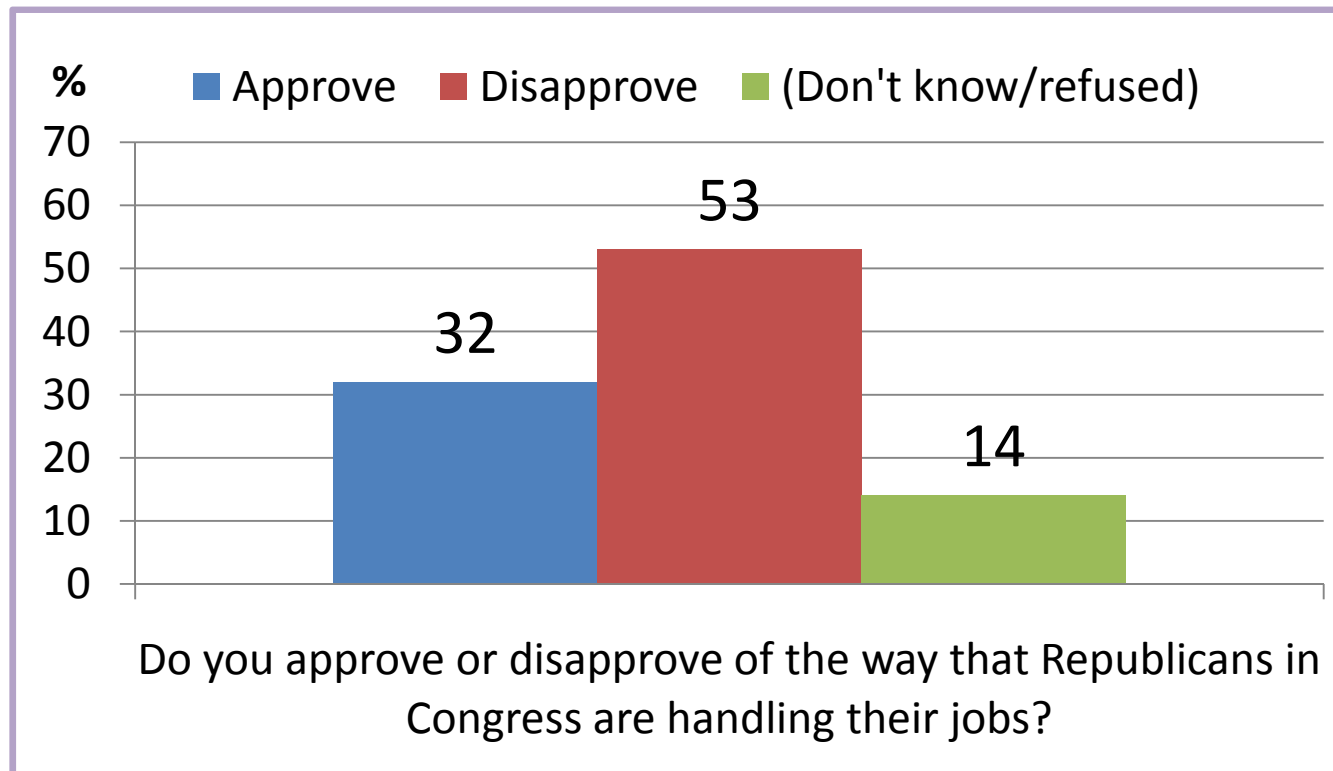
## LARGE MAJORITY IN NC STILL SAYS COUNTRY IS ON THE WRONG TRACK



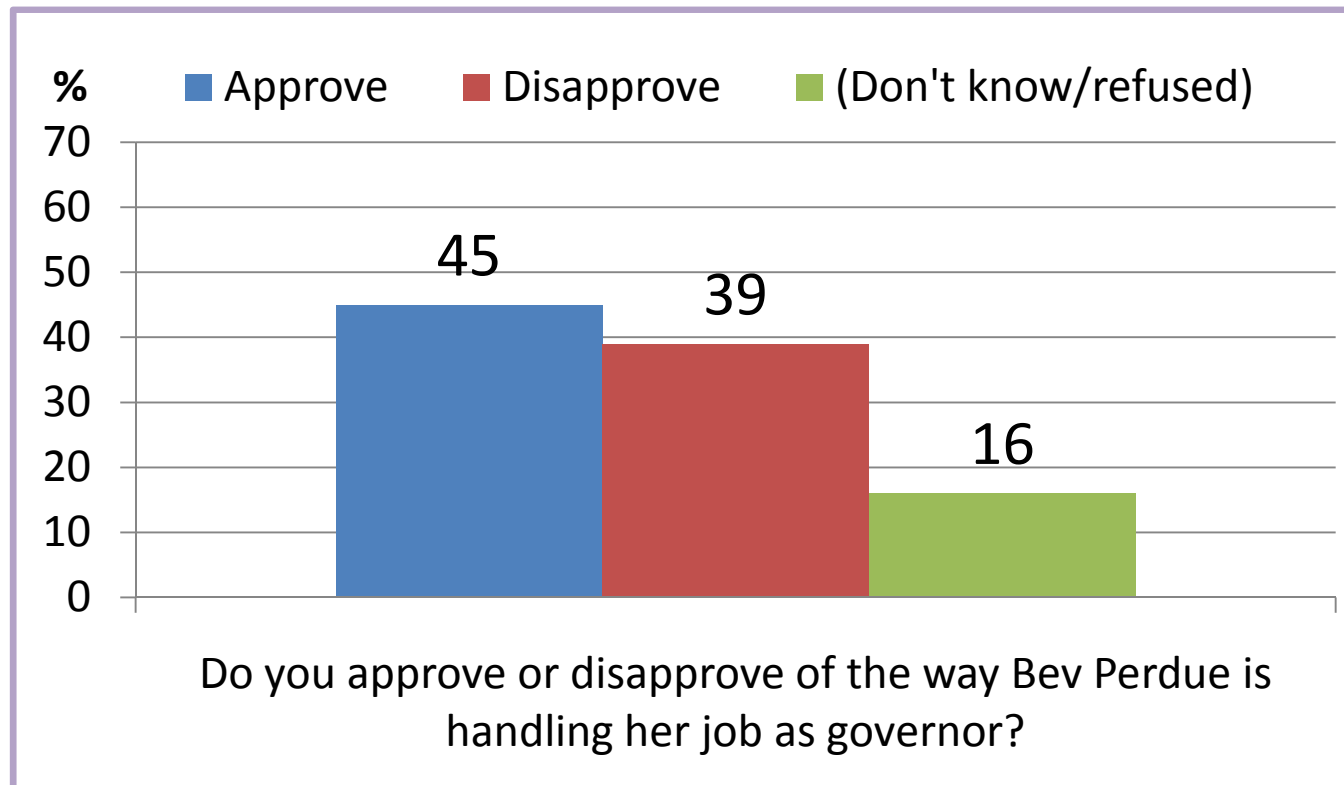
## PLURALITY OF NORTH CAROLINIANS APPROVE OF HOW PRESIDENT OBAMA IS HANDLING HIS JOB



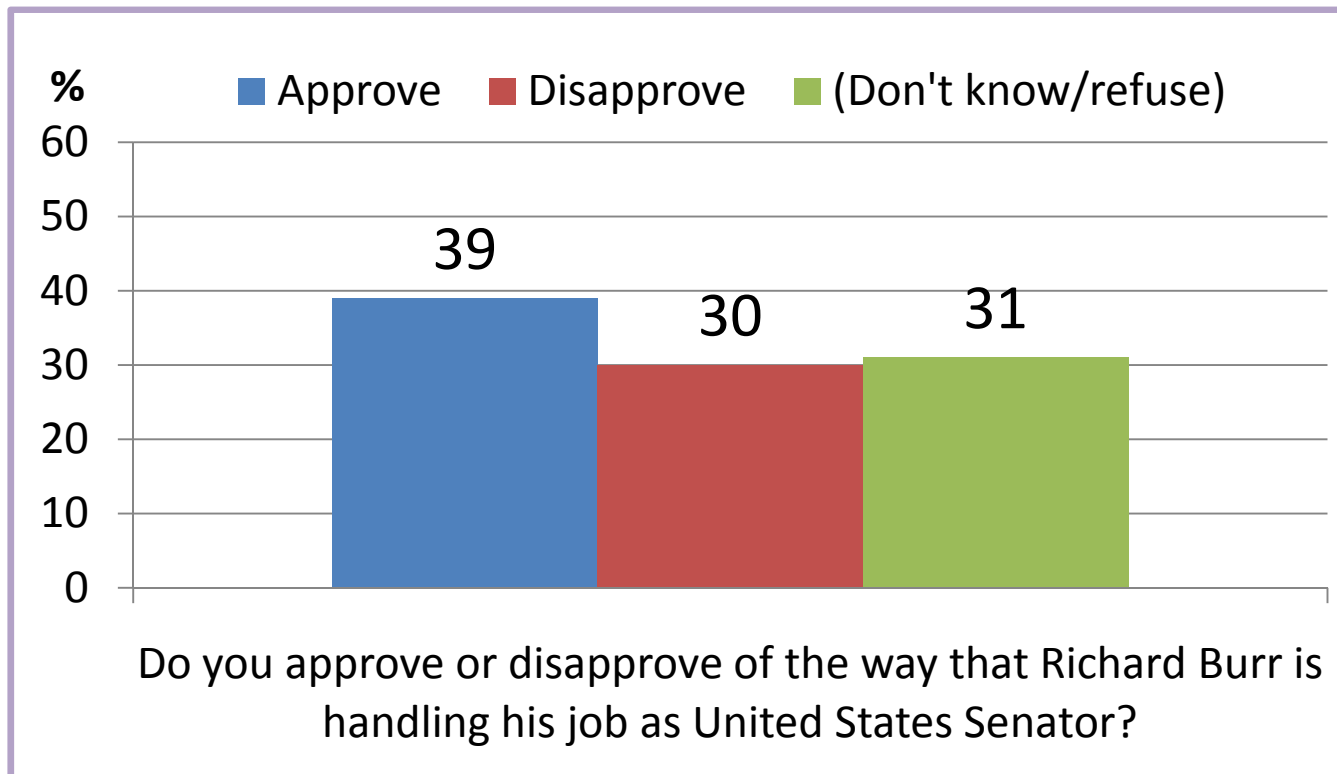
## MAJORITY IN NC DISAPPROVES OF THE WAY REPUBLICANS IN CONGRESS ARE HANDLING THEIR JOBS



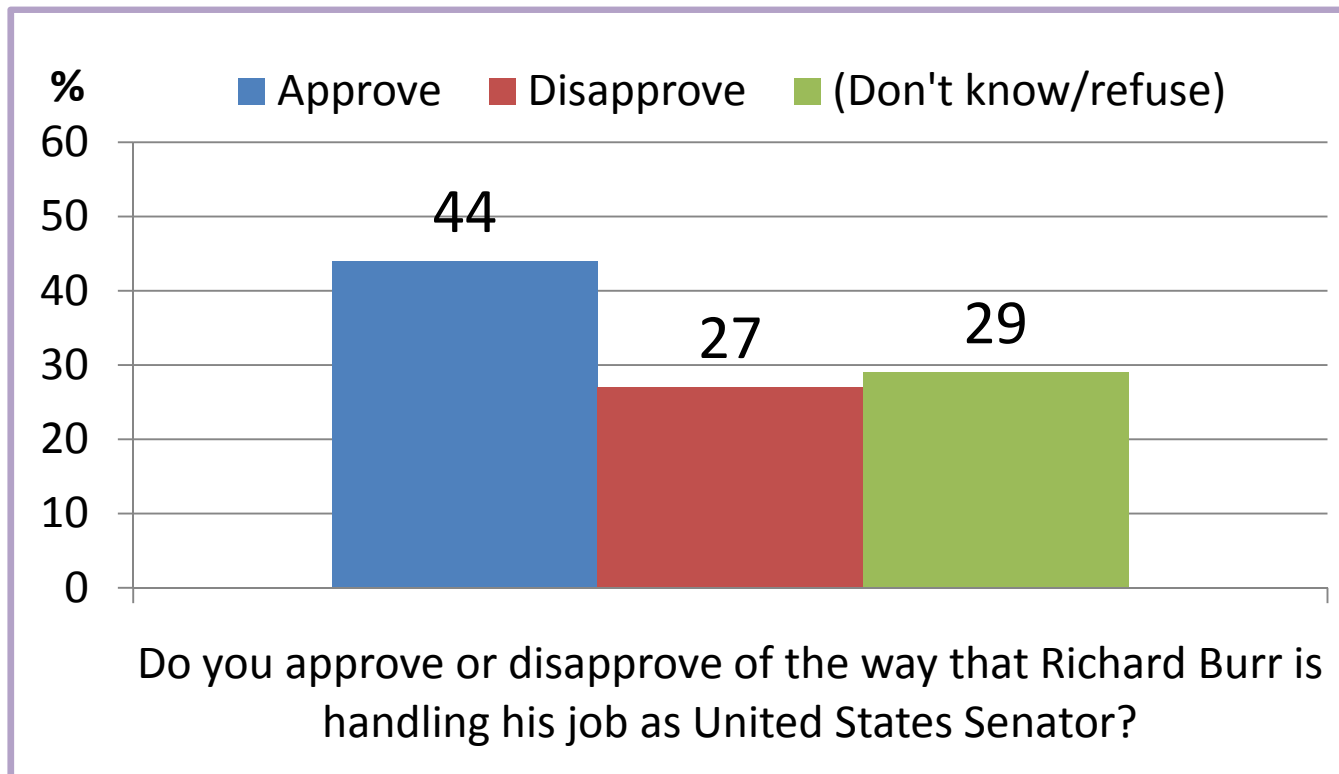
## PLURALITY IN NC APPROVES OF THE WAY BEV PERDUE IS HANDLING HER JOB AS GOVERNOR



## PLURALITY IN NC APPROVES OF THE WAY RICHARD BURR IS HANDLING HIS JOB AS UNITED STATES SENATOR

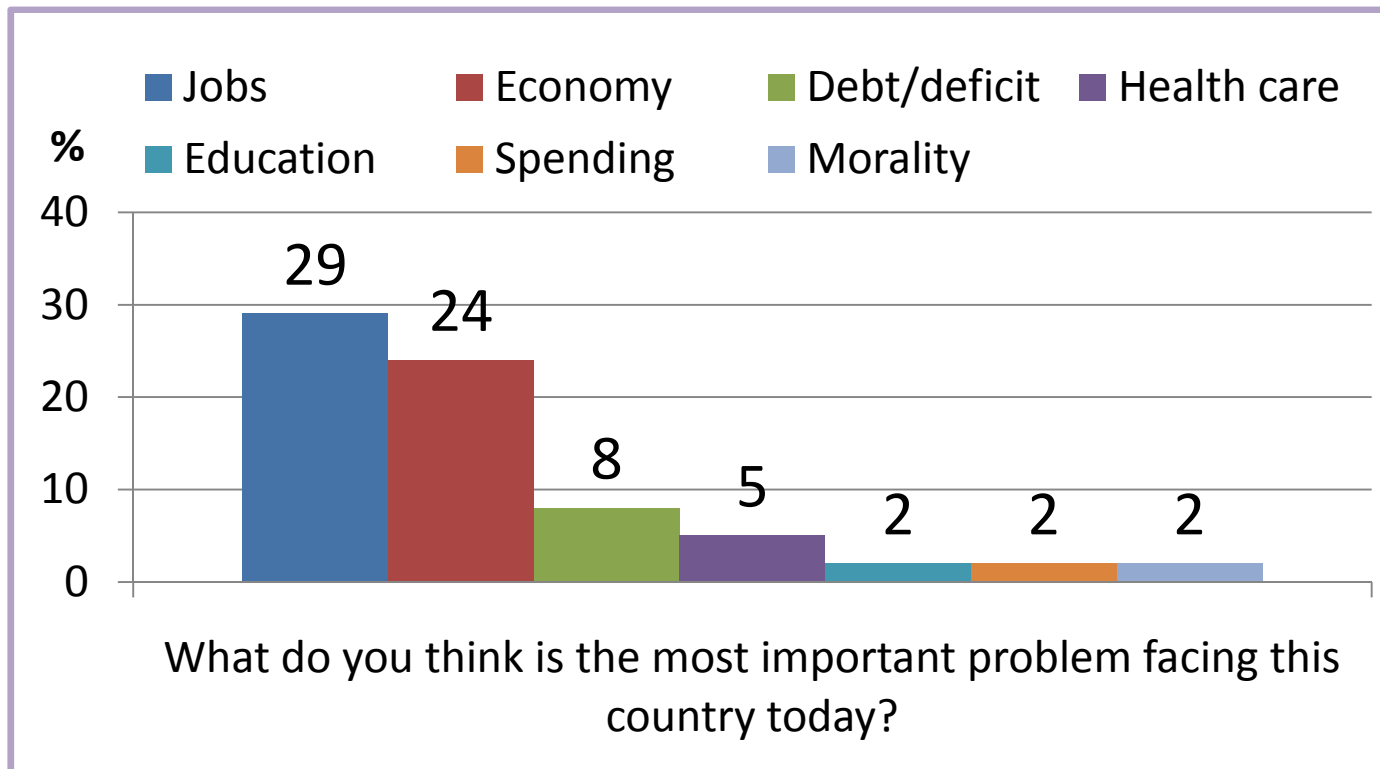


## PLURALITY IN NC APPROVE OF THE WAY KAY HAGAN IS HANDLING HER JOB AS UNITED STATES SENATOR

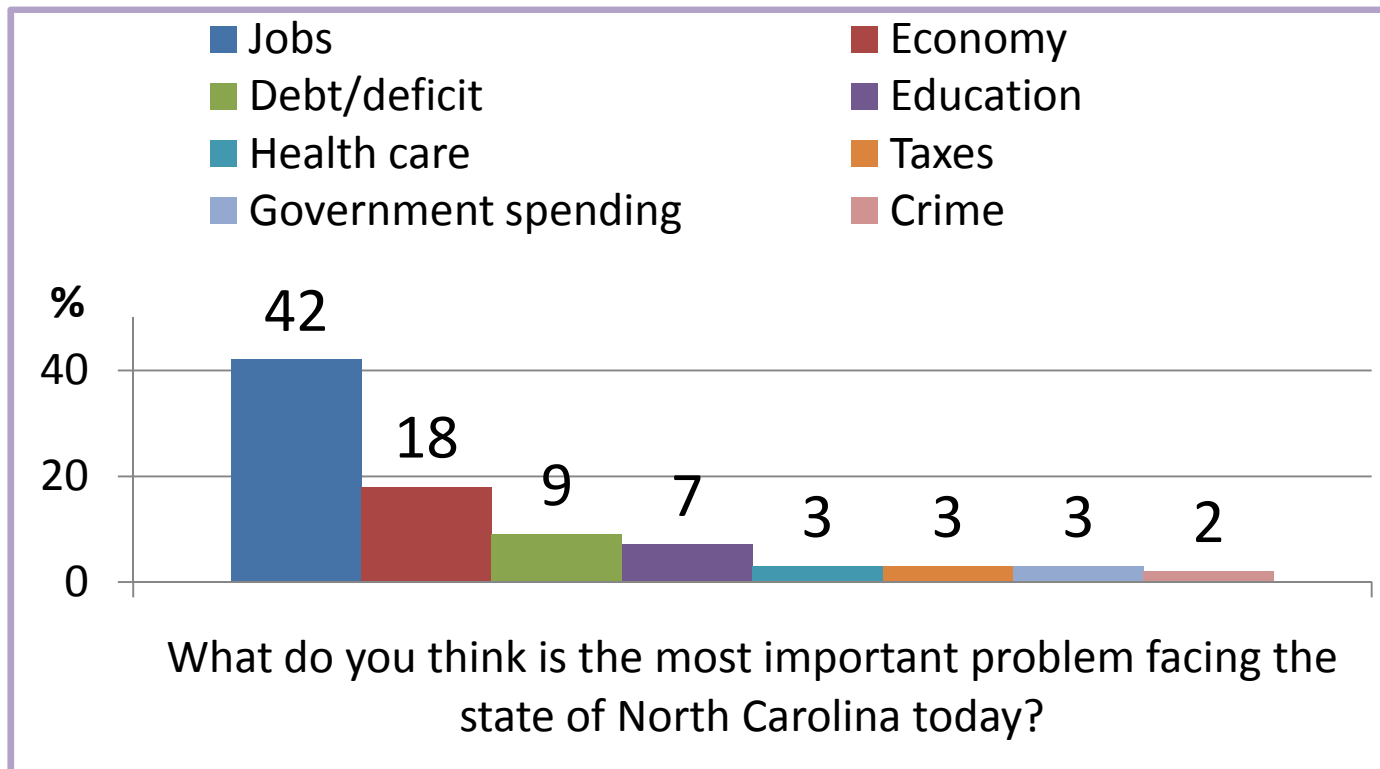




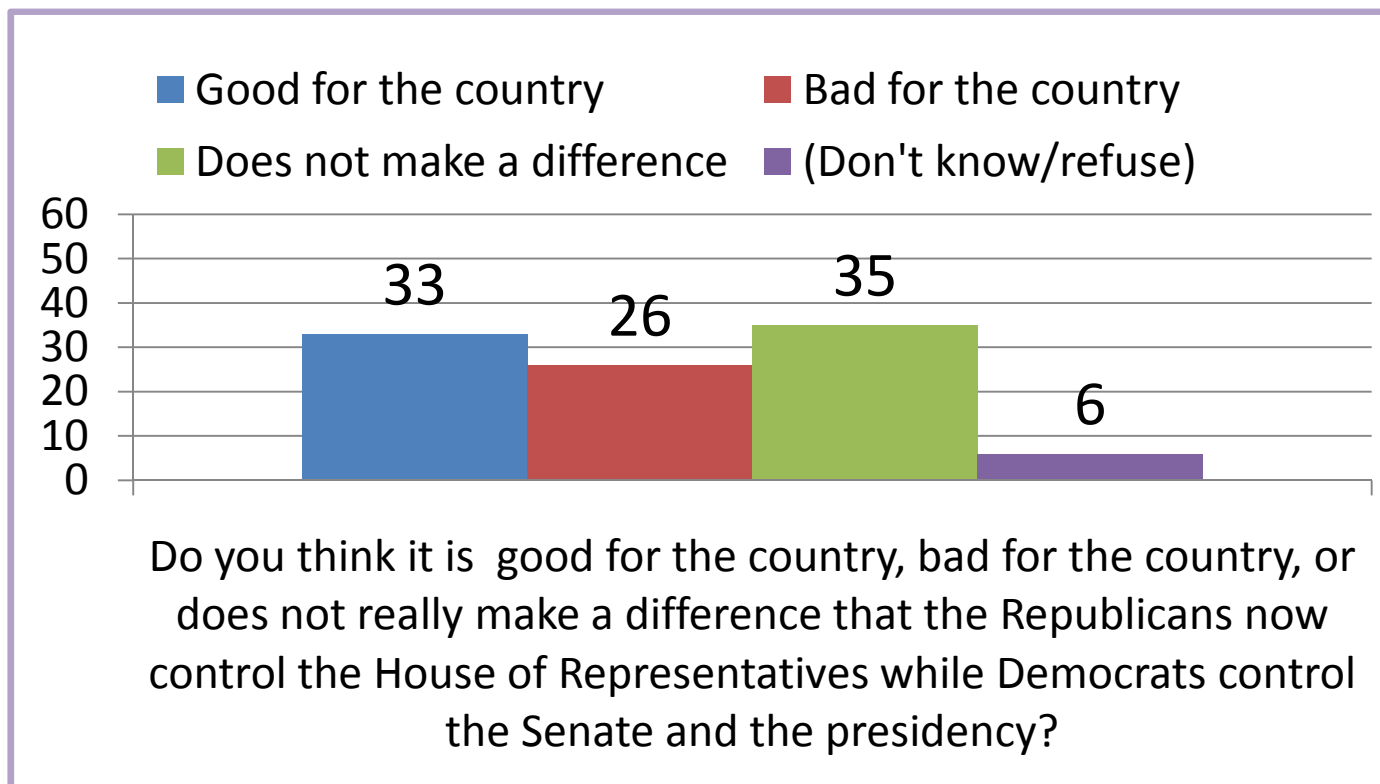
## JOBS AND THE ECONOMY ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT PROBLEMS FACING THE COUNTRY TODAY



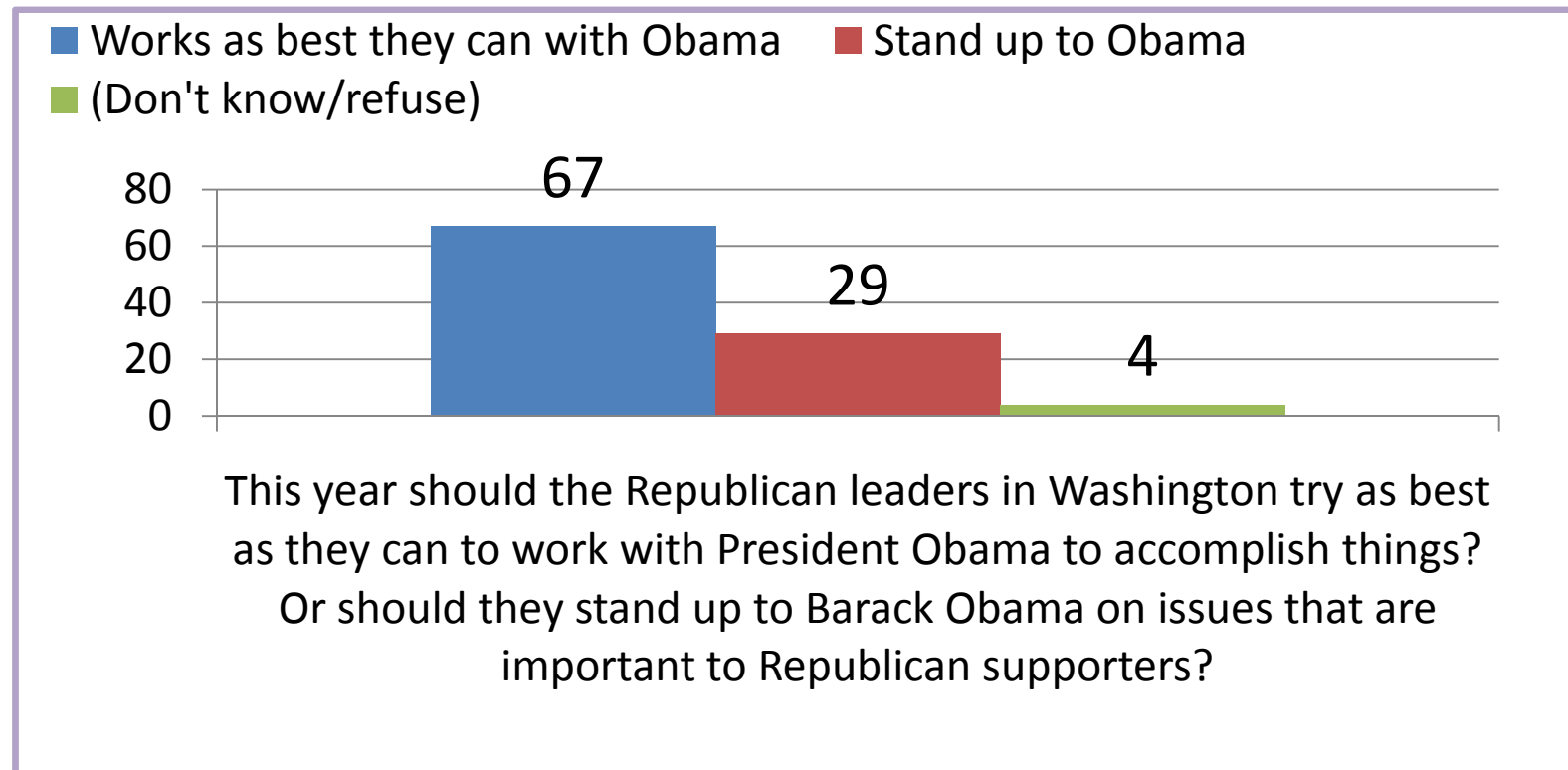

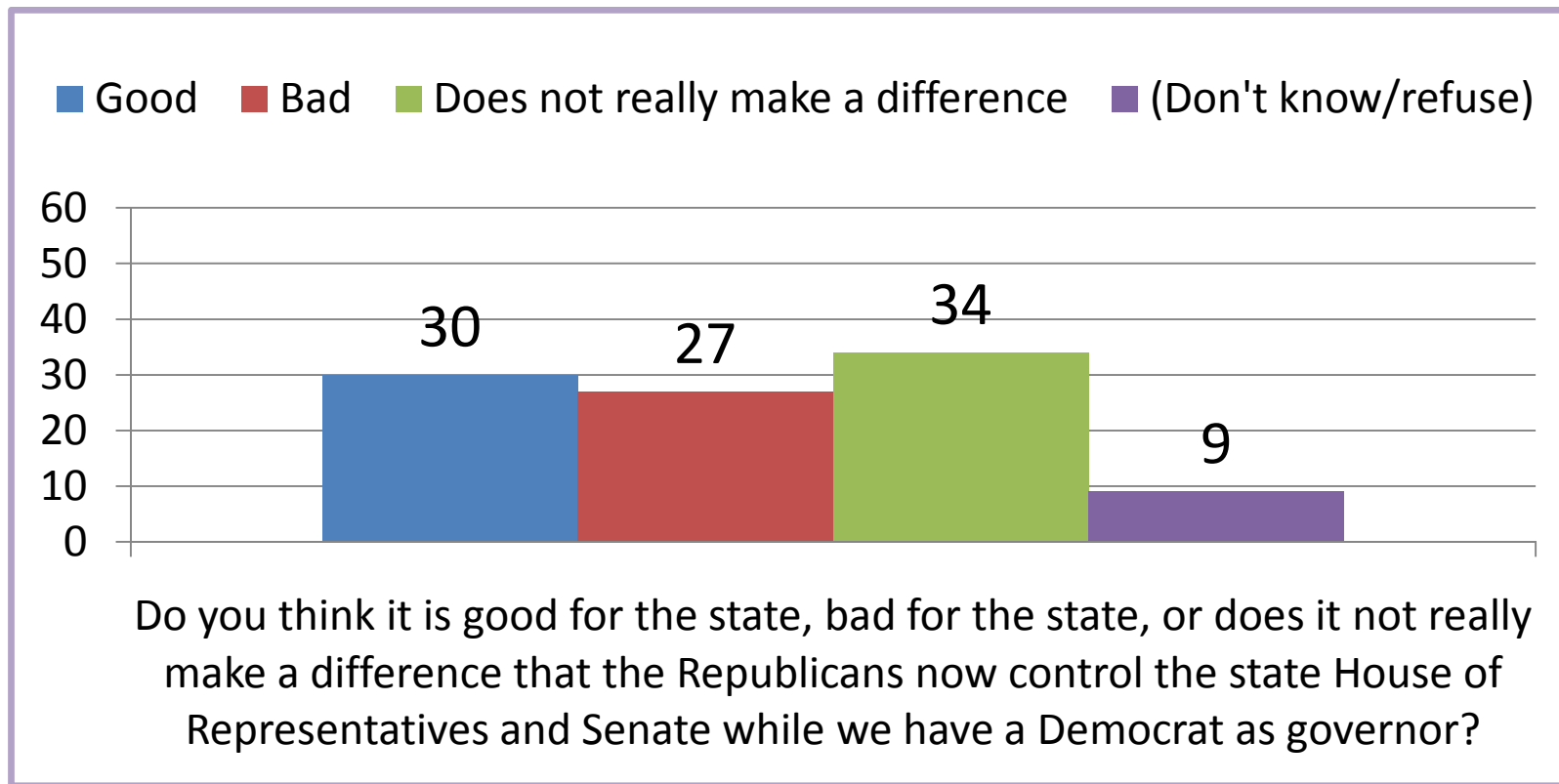

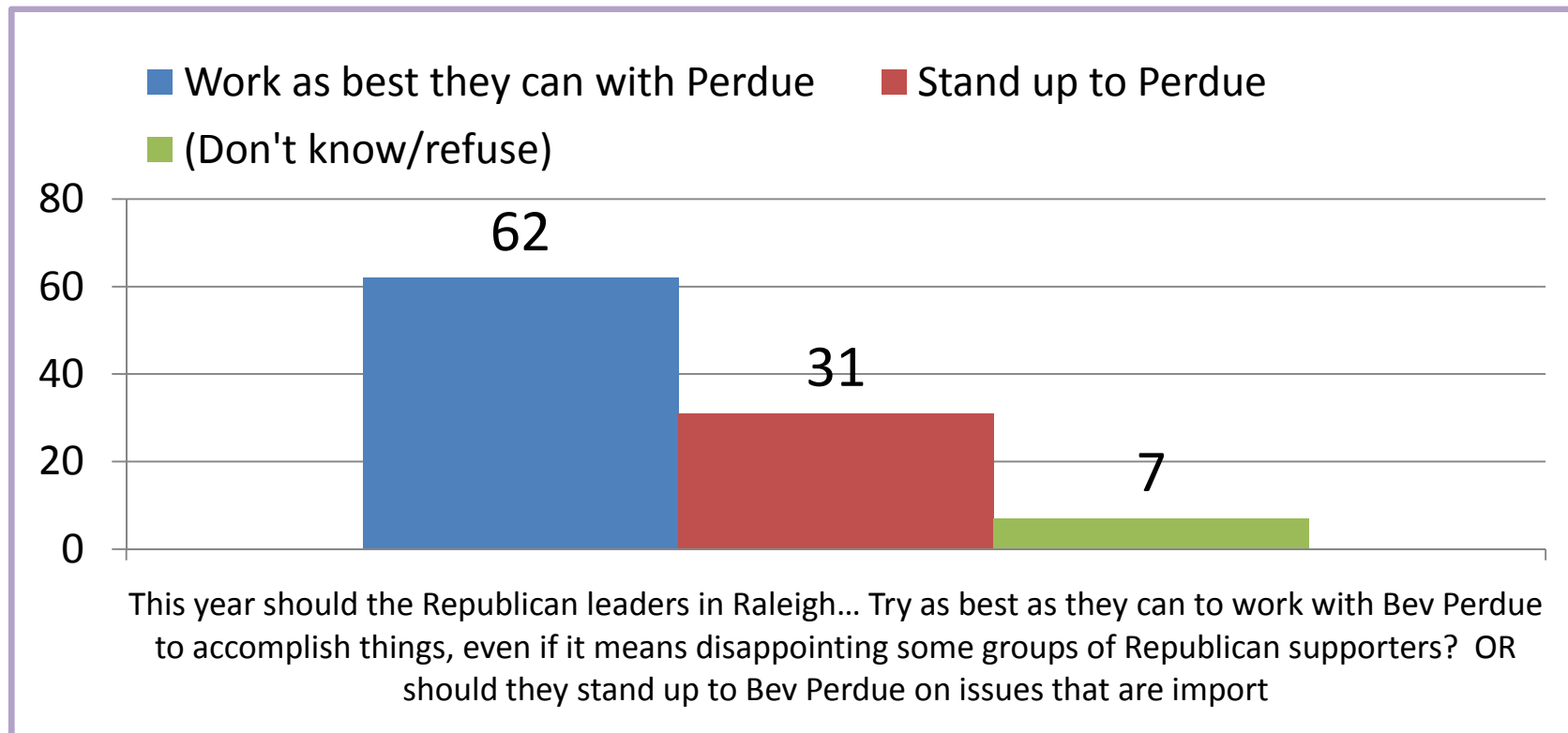

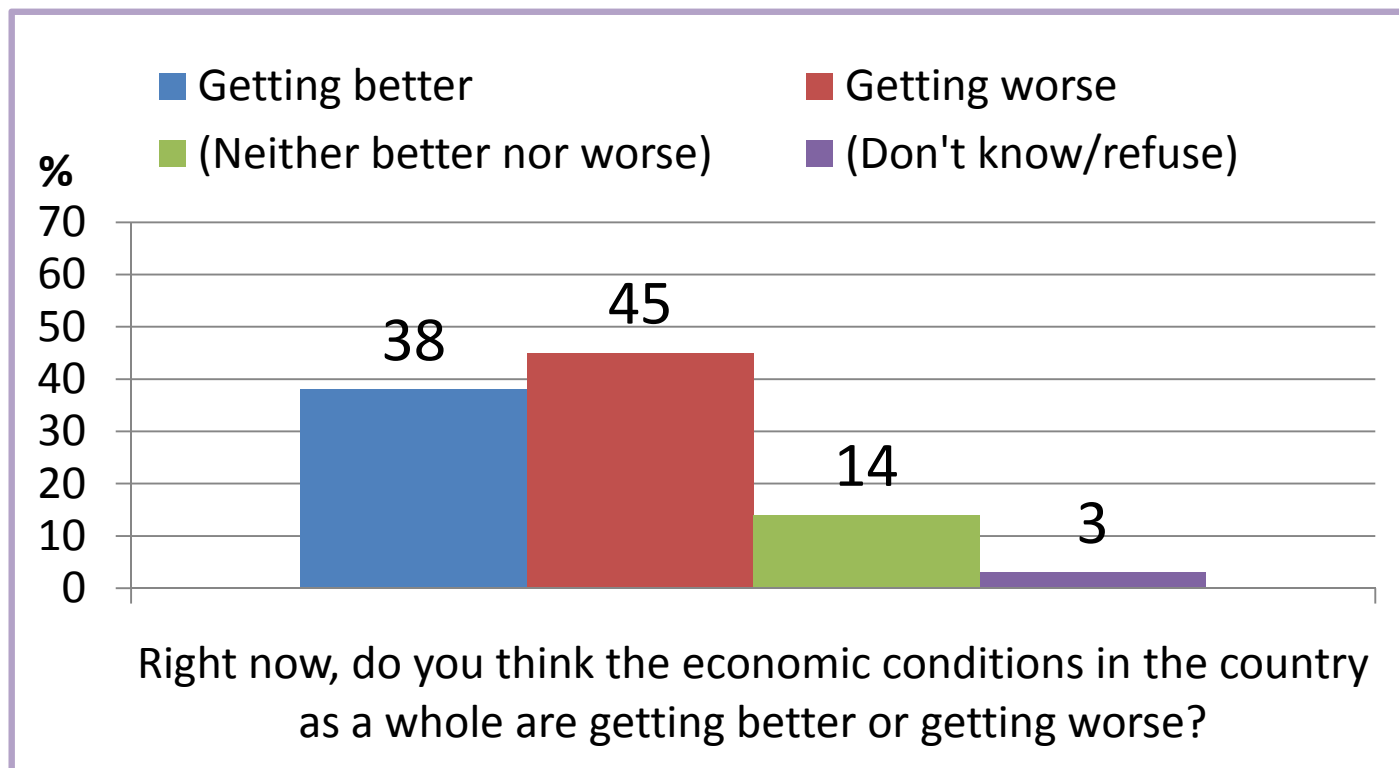

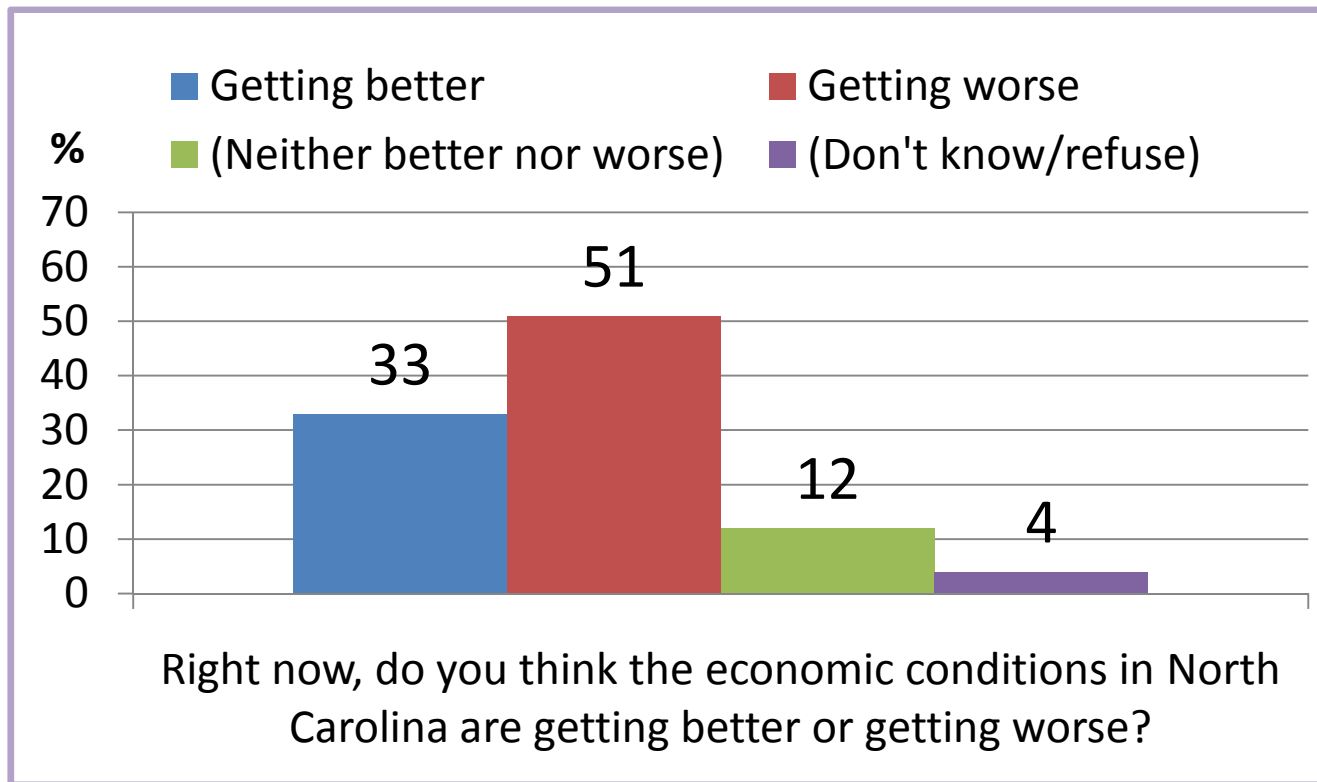
## MAJORITY IN NC SAY REPUBLICAN LEADERS IN RALEIGH SHOULD WORK WITH PERDUE



## MAJORITY IN NC SAYS ECONOMIC CONDITIONS IN COUNTRY ARE GETTING WORSE

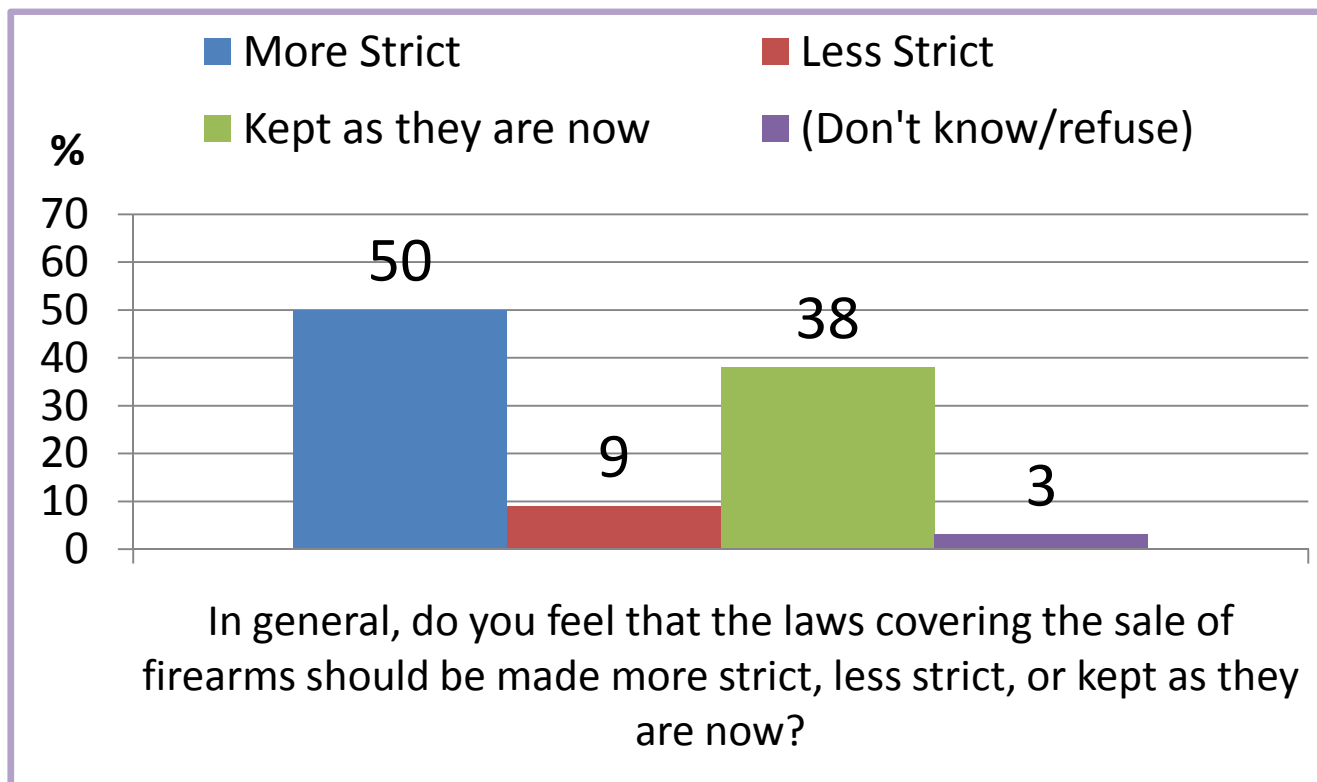
