

Character Conversations


Imagine your students chatting with literary characters. Transform passive reading into active dialogue.


Students can ask AI to "be" a character and respond in their voice.

It can deepen literary analysis.

Idea Generation

Al can generate ideas or main points on a specific topic. This could be a great way to get started or a step in forming research questions. Students could ask the Al something like "What ideas need further development in the research about _____ topic?" or something like "What main points should an essay on ____ cover?"





Content Comparison

Students could draft content about a specific topic or with some specific theme/ strategy and then ask AI to do the same. Then, they could reflect on the rhetorical differences between them and ultimately think about the human aspect of writing and how it is uncovered in this process.
