Eligible students will participate in a second internship related to sport management and have a 2.3 overall GPA, a 2.5 GPA in Event Management courses, and a minimum of 16 credits from the Event Management major, including an introductory course in EMG and an advanced level EMG course. Prerequisites: EMG 1200 and EMG 2300. Four credits.

Enter the proposed NEW course description

Students will participate in an internship related to event management. To be eligible, students must have a 2.3 overall GPA and a minimum of 16 credits from the Event Management major, including an introductory course in EMG and an advanced level EMG course. The student must complete 160 clock hours at the site. If a student does not have the required GPA, he/she must take a course from the list of approved electives provided by the event management program. Prerequisites: EMG 1200 and EMG 2300. Variable credit and repeatable up to 12 hours.
