Rationale for above changes

MGT 3220, Leadership, is a junior level course. Typically, the enrollment in our MGT 3220 sections is equally split between sophomores and juniors. During the spring 2023 semester, we had several freshman enrolled in MGT 3220. This was due to MGT 2220 being considered a "co-enrollment" course during the fall 2022 semester. Noting that first-semester freshman did not perform well in MGT 2220, we withdrew MGT 2220 from being offered as a co-enrollment course. We subsequently noted that these freshman also did not fair well in MGT 3220.

This semester (fall 2023), we again have new freshman enrolled in MGT 3220 sections. They had met the prerequisite (i.e., completion of MGT 2220), by completing MGT 2220 through summer advantage or completing it through dual enrollment at their high school during their last semester.

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Our experience is that freshman do not perform well in MGT 3220. They lack the maturity needed for this course. By retaining the prerequisite "MGT 2220" and adding to this "sophomore standing," we hope to alleviate this situation.
