Adding/Removing Academic Programs**Please describe the change you are seeking to make and provide a rationale**

We are seeking to adding the Experiential Learning designation to our PSY 4100 Advanced Research Methods course owing to it's fitting with the requirements for Experiential Learning:

- Would have to demonstrate learning taking place beyond that of a typical classroom --> Students work throughout the entire semester on an individually developed and executed psychological research project, from written proposal through products of research (e.g., conference poster abstracts, poster, and oral presentation). The majority of the work done in this course is in fact out-of-class work in addition to collaborative meetings with the faculty instructor beyond that of scheduled class time.

• Would need to demonstrate the engagement of students in experiential learning activities for a significant component (at least 1 credit hour worth) of the course. --> Most of the credits within this course are earned through independent research (recruitment of participants, data collection, analyses, and presentation to peer audience).

• Could include department capstones, practicums, or other courses --> Advanced Methods is currently our "capstone" learning experience for our majors.
