Distribution Requirement Changes**What is being changed?**

1) Replace "CSC 1610 or CSC 1705" with "CSC 1710" 2) Remove "or STS 3210"

Rationale for change (brief)

1) CSC 1610 and 1705 are no longer being taught. 2) STS 3210 is being removed (current proposal)

Rationale for above changes

For the CSC requirement, neither CSC 1610 nor CSC 1705 are being taught in the CS department any longer. Actuarial Science majors will be required to take CSC 1710 going forward. This is consistent with the previous requirement in the major.

On item 2, another current proposal is to remove STS 3210, so this aligns the ACTS degree with this course removal.

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This does not affect CS, in that our majors are already taking CSC 1710 due to the other courses not being offered. So there is no effective change in CSC enrollments.
