Rationale for above changes

MGT 3600 introduces the topic of healthcare management and provides an introductory understanding of the leadership, management, and organization of the healthcare industry to include hospitals, healthcare systems, physician practices, insurers,

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state and federal government agencies, pharmaceutical/medical device manufacturers, and public health organizations, whether for-profit or not-for-profit.

This foundational information is required for the student to successfully understanding the topics of managing healthcare organizations, healthcare delivery systems, funding of healthcare delivery, healthcare human resource management, and healthcare strategic manager, which will be presented in subsequent courses. In addition, MGT 4690 will require students to critically examine organizational, strategic business unit, and functional-level vision, mission, and values statements; analyze and draw meaningful conclusions from internal and external assessments using a variety of established tools and techniques; formulate well-conceived organizational goals, objectives, and strategies; and present tactical implementation and monitoring plans. Consequently, both completion of MGT 3600 and junior standing will ensure students enter this course with the background needed to be successful.
