Rationale for above changes

The original course title was a function of a broader proposal for a proposed BS degree in Nutrition. The course was to be part of a curriculum sequence with a series of foundational courses. However, the proposal of a nutrition-based degree program was not realized for implementation.

The term ADVANCED is an unnecessary descriptor in relationship to the present structure of the curriculum for the BS.EXS and BA.H&W degree programs. Secondly the term functions as an artificially inflates students' perception of what is required to enroll in the course. Removing ADAVENCED from the course title would simplify and eliminate a barrier for student enrollment.
