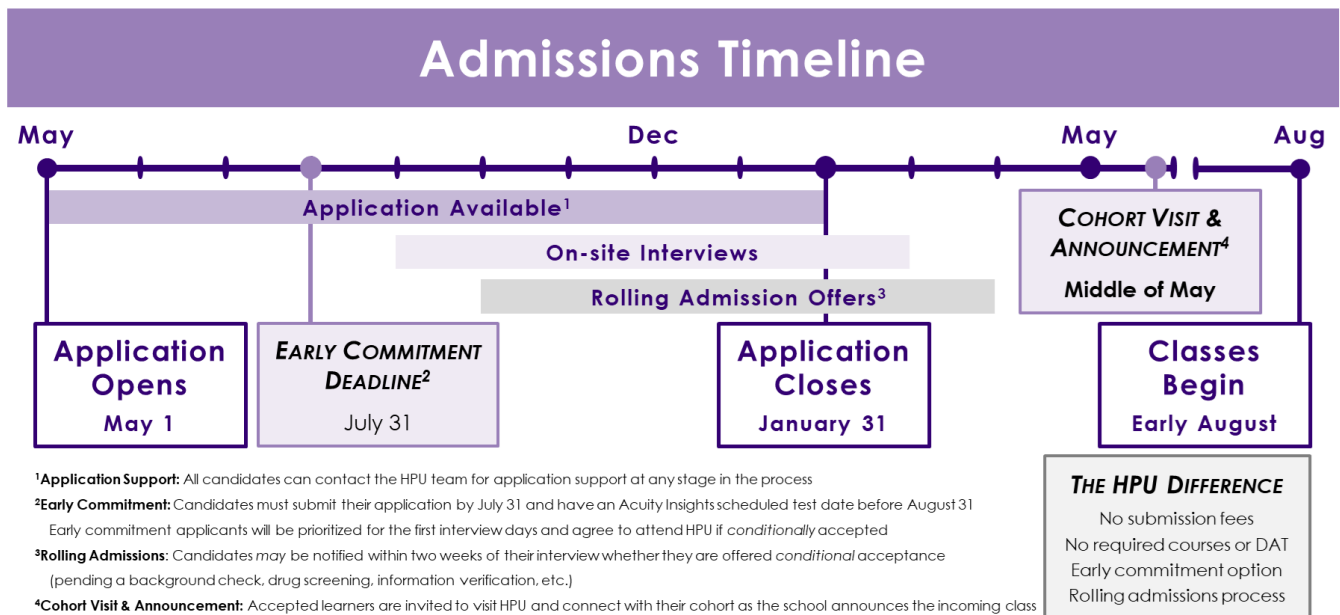

The HPU WSDM is **NOT participating in the ADEA AADSAS application** for the current admission cycle. Your application will be submitted through **our website**, which will generate a unique identifier. Please record this number for your records and for the Acuity Insights Assessment. In the portal, you can save your progress and submit your application when it is complete. Additional troubleshooting information can be found in our application assistance document.

Your application must be submitted by **January 31, 2024**. Candidates interest in **early commitment must submit by July 31, 2023**. The application includes the following sections **plus** external assessments through [Acuity Insights](#).
