

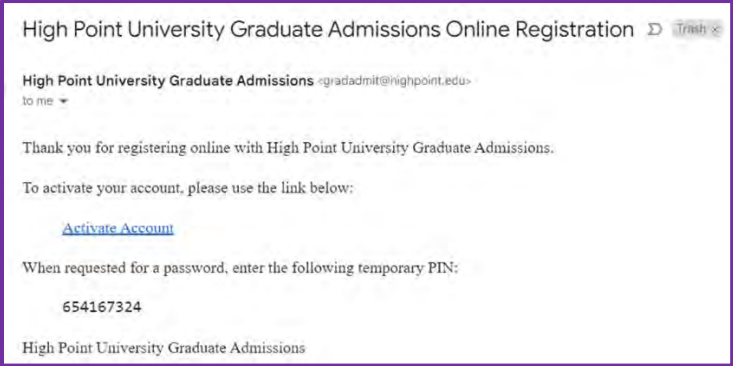


Image of Starting a New Application

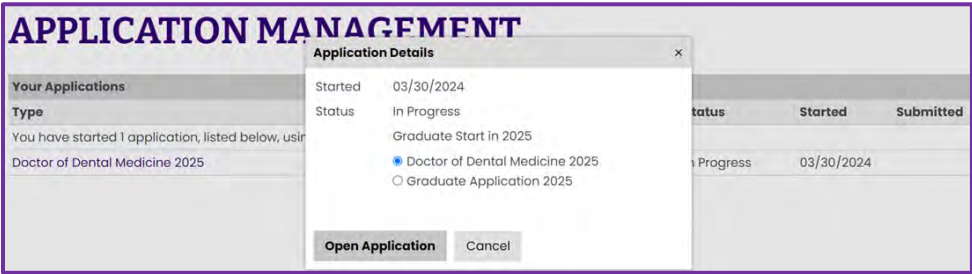
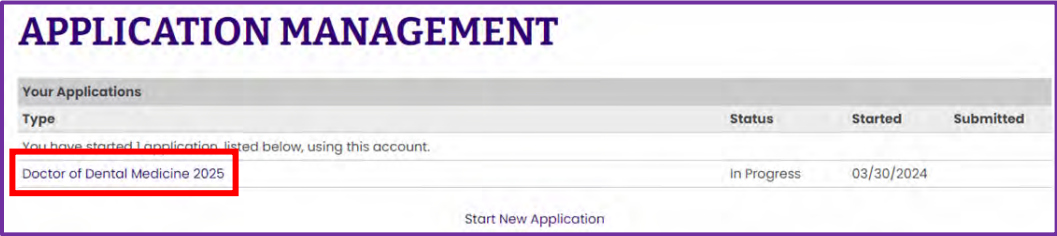


Image of Application Dashboard





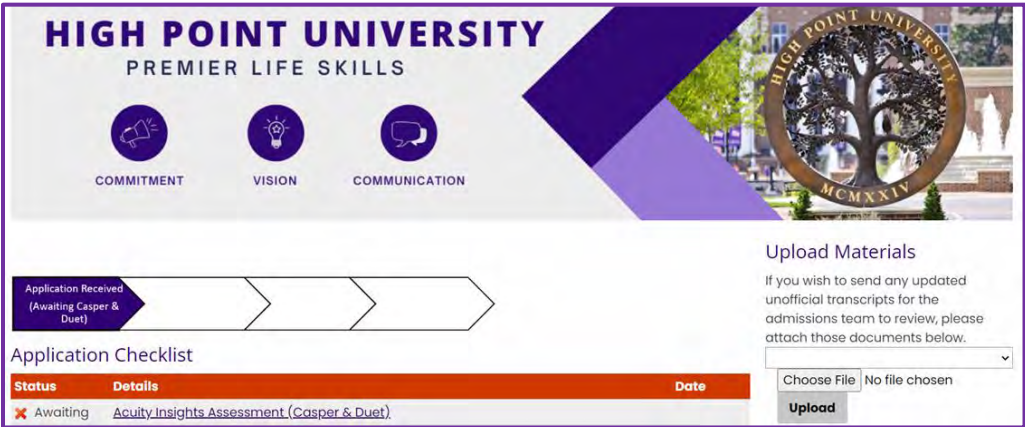


Image of Application Status & Document Upload Option

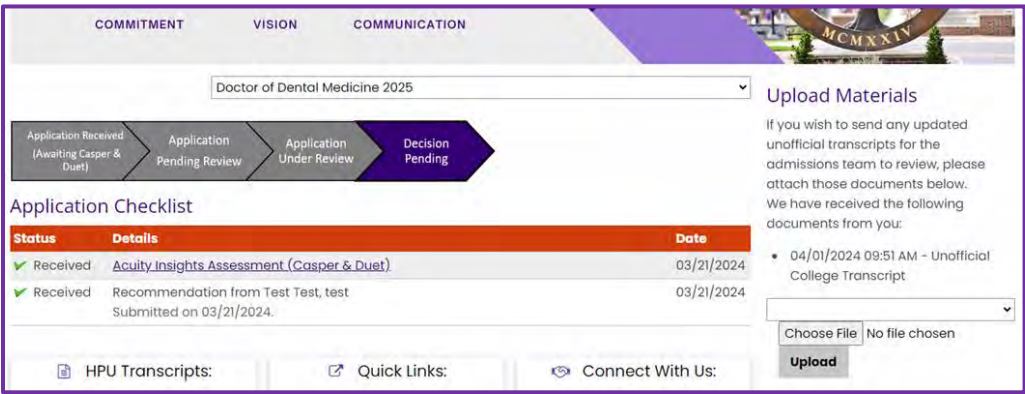
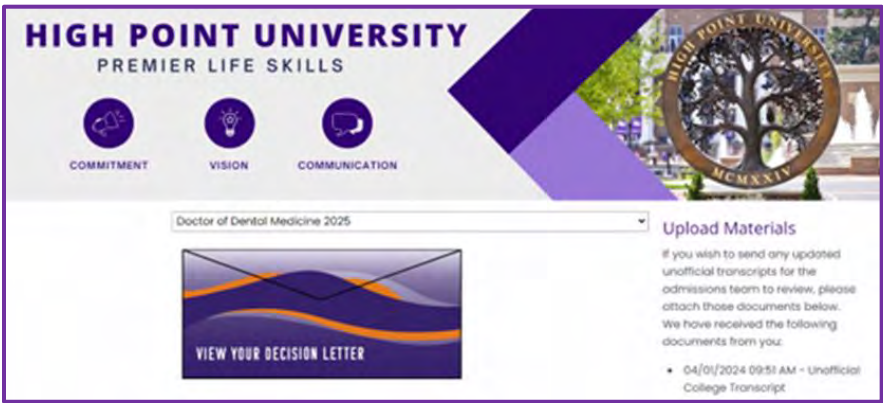
