### Living Expenses

Living expenses will vary depending on your budgeting, family size, and current economic conditions.

A sample list of items that may be included in your budget is provided below.

Estimated Annual Living Expenses	\$25,000 to \$40,000
Sample Living Expenses	Example Semester Budget
Rent/mortgage	\$1000-1800 per month (shared space)
Vehicle payment/insurance/gas	\$500-1000 per month
Meals/food	\$800-1200 per month
Cell phone, internet, & subscriptions	\$100-200 per month
Utilities (water, electric, gas)	\$100-150 per month
Medical insurance & costs	\$2500-3500 annually
Computer & electronics	\$1500 (for each need)
Entertainment & personal travel	\$1000-2500 annually (based on interests)
Conferences, memberships, & interviews	\$1000-2000 annually (based on interests)
