

Minimum Requirements for Non CODA Accredited Graduates

The table below reflects the minimum requirements for graduates of non-coda accredited programs for consideration for admission.

Requirement Category	Non-CODA Accredited Applicants
Dental Degree	Graduation from a recognized non-CODA-accredited dental school
Citizenship/Residency Requirement	Applicants must be either a United States citizen or United States permanent resident (Green Card holder)
Minimum Dental School GPA	Minimum equivalent GPA of 3.5 or higher
U.S. Graduate Degree Exception	Applicants with a completed U.S.-based master's degree or higher may be considered with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher in the graduate program
Credential Evaluation	Mandatory course-by-course evaluation through ECE or WES
INBDE	Successful completion of the INBDE prior to application review
TOEFL Requirement	Minimum TOEFL iBT score of 90
Letters of Recommendation	Minimum of 3 letters of recommendation required
Preferred Recommendation Sources	Letter from Dean of graduating institution required, other letters can be of personal choice
