Each graduate certificate includes three courses offered at an advanced academic level, which can be taken as non-degree earning or may be applied towards fulfilling the requirements of a graduate degree. When completed in conjunction with state licensure requirements, degrees may also yield a principal or superintendent license for the state of North Carolina. Completion of individual certificates will position educators for employment in specialized roles. All certificate courses are aligned to both national AAQEP and North Carolina Department of Public Instruction standards for accreditation.
