To be considered for the Alice Armfield Grant-in-Aid, the applicant must fulfill each of the following requirements and reply by **March 1, 2025**.

1. Applicant must be a rising senior in the field of education or a Master of Education Graduate Candidate from High Point University. *Former Alice Armfield recipients are not eligible to apply.*
 2. Attach a copy of college transcript.
 3. Attach a letter of reference from an instructor and/or an employer. Do not include relatives.
 4. Include a brief statement (one page or less) indicating why you wish to enter the field of education, your professional goals, and why you need financial assistance. (See page 3).
 5. Provide confirmation that you reside in Davidson, Guilford, or Randolph County, have plans to teach within these counties, or plan to teach within the State of North Carolina.
Preference will be given to students demonstrating financial need and/or plan to teach in North Carolina.
 6. Any recipient who fails to complete the program will forfeit the Alice Armfield Grant-In-Aid to the next alternate candidate.

- The selected candidate will be notified via email in mid-March and will be invited as a guest to the Beta Omicron, Beta Xi, and Chi DKG Spring Banquet. Spring Banquet will be held on April 14th, 2025 at 5:30 p.m. at Green Street Baptist Church in High Point.
