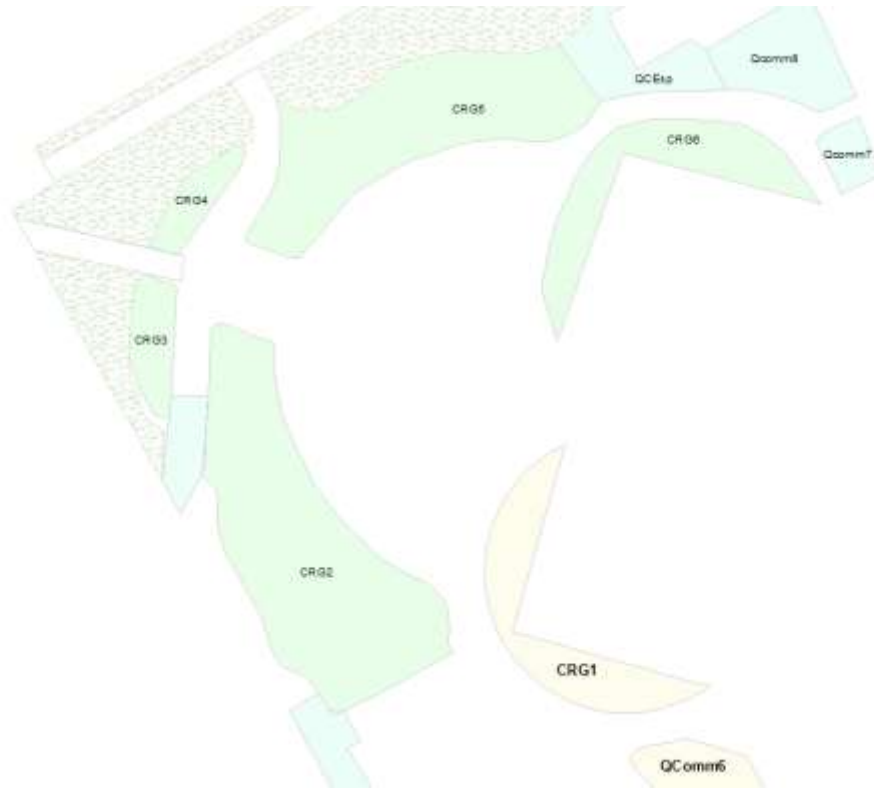


The Pat Plaxico Climbing Rose Garden
