Library Technology Conditions of Use

Library technology services

- Access to HPU WiFi
- Two computers with Internet access, Microsoft 365, and Adobe suite.
- HPU FollowMePrint station with scanner
- Access to electronic resources with either specific law school access or your HPU Single Sign-On

Using library computers

- You will need your HPU Single Sign-On to access the computers.
- Use of computers or Internet to access content or conduct processes that are illegal, obscene, or otherwise inappropriate for a public setting will be treated as “unacceptable behavior” under the Patron Services agreement.

- Make sure files are saved to your OneDrive account, as locally saved files will be deleted.
- Respect library property and do not damage or vandalize the computers in any way.

Using electronic resources*

- Use of electronic and online resources is governed by copyright law and individual license terms of use.
- Some general principles apply for permitted and prohibited uses.
- Normally Permitted:
 - Viewing, downloading, copying, printing, and saving individual articles or search results.
 - Using e-resources for research and teaching.
 - Sending a copy of an article to another current HPU user.
 - Sharing the URL, or posting it.
 - Citing small portions of content in your published research.
- Normally Prohibited: (NOTE: Engagement in any of the activities below may result in suspension of your access, and possibly in suspension of access for all HPU users.)

- Systematically downloading or distributing large volumes of material.
- Using HPU Libraries electronic resources for personal commercial gain.
- Sharing content with non-HPU users.
- Publicly posting the text of books, journal articles or digital photos, drawings, or other content from HPU Libraries electronic resources.
- You are expected to comply with the terms of use for the electronic resources you use.
- Terms of use can usually be found on publishers' websites or via links from their pages.
