Visitor Policy

As an independent private institution, High Point University provides an academic library for the use of its students, faculty, and staff. Other individuals are welcome to visit the library in accordance with university policies. The University reserves the right to restrict any individual from using its materials, equipment, facilities, or services.

High Point University libraries are open to any visitor to campus during normal weekday operating hours; normally 8am to 5pm. Visitors should check-in with security when entering campus and will be directed to parking. Smith Library is located next to Roberts Hall. A scholar or researcher that needs to make extensive use of content held by the library, may request permission by contacting the Director of Library Services at HPULibraries@highpoint.edu or by calling 336-841-9215.

Rules concerning library use:

Use of the Library collection and its services such as printing, and computer use are reserved for HPU students, faculty, and staff. Exceptions to this rule may include retired faculty, trustees and other “special friends” of the University as defined by the university administration. These patrons will need to communicate about access with the Director of Library Services or the Head of Circulation.

TALA (*Triad Academic Library Association) affiliated library patrons:

TALA patrons may have access to Smith Library to check out materials as per the TALA agreement. Before TALA patrons can borrow materials, they must show that they are a member of their school by showing an ID and demonstrating electronic access as a proof of that membership. TALA patrons can borrow materials as defined by the borrowing parameters established by each school.
