

## Approved Substitutions for AY 2025-2026 for Students Who Have Received an Official Substitution of the General Education Requirement in Foreign Language

The courses below have been approved as substitutions for required foreign language courses. If all or part of the foreign language requirement has been approved for substitution, the student must substitute only **one** of the following courses. Courses completed to fulfill other General Education requirements (INDIS/FYWRT/MODFL/ETRLT/NTSCL/SOSCI/ARTS/HUMAN) **cannot** be used to fulfill the Foreign Language requirement.
