## **DIRECTED STUDY**

A directed study is defined as the enrollment in a regular catalog course without the usual class sessions, using as a substitute, individual meetings between the student and instructor.

Directed studies are available to students who are within one or two semesters of graduation & who have no alternate means of satisfying degree requirements other than enrolling for an additional semester.

A directed study may not be used to repeat a course & the student must meet the minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

The maximum number of courses that may be taken via directed study is four (4) with only one (1) directed study being undertaken during an given term.

A directed study must be taught by a full-time faculty member & the original syllabus of the course must be followed.

The minimum student contact with the instructor will be five (5) hours per semester credit. A proposed schedule of meetings between the student and the instructor <u>must</u> accompany this application at the time of submission to the Office of the University Registrar.
