



Dual Enrollment & Transfer Credit Information for Incoming Students

High Point University accepts most transfer credit from any regionally accredited institution provided a C or better is earned (P/F, S, or C- and below are not accepted).

Certain types of courses will not transfer. This includes, but are not limited to remedial courses, nursing, and technical courses such as construction, aviation, EMS, culinary arts, horticulture, cosmetology, etc.

To receive credit, an official transcript must be sent directly from the transferring institution to High Point University. This can be done electronically or through traditional mail. Copies sent to the student/parent, then forwarded to HPU are not considered official and will not be processed.

Students who have earned course credit by transfer or through dual enrollment, CLEP, AP, or IB credit, and who wish to retake the course at High Point University for credit and a letter grade, may do so provided they submit a written request to the Registrar's Office and confirm their understanding that the transfer credit will be removed from their HPU transcript and that the letter grade and credit earned in the course at High Point University will stand.
