

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)

ALLOWS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES TO OBTAIN ACCESSIBLE HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS
THROUGH THE OFFICE OF ACCESSIBILITY RESOURCES AND SERVICES (OARS)

IMPORTANT DATES FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

FEBRUARY 12	DEADLINE TO HAVE ALL NEW OR RENEWAL REQUESTS SUBMITTED AND APPROVED BY OARS
FEBRUARY 13	\$750 HOUSING DEPOSIT DUE
FEBRUARY 17-21	HOMESTEADING
END OF FEBRUARY - EARLY MARCH	ADA HOUSING OFFERS MADE

CAN I HOMESTEAD? YES, BUT...

Any student who is eligible to participate in homesteading is welcome to do so. However, Housing cannot guarantee that where you homestead will meet your accommodations. Housing will reach out after homesteading to let you know if it meets your accommodations or offer an alternative housing assignment if it does not, which students can then accept or decline.

ADA OFFERS

Housing will reach out to all students with ADA Housing Accommodations to extend an ADA offer. Offers are subject to availability. Offer locations are determined by a student's unique accommodations, and Housing is unable to take personal preference into account when making an offer. Once an offer is made, students will need to respond with their decision within the appropriate timeframe or they forfeit their ADA offer.



Once an offer is made, a student can either

ACCEPT

- Housing assignment will be the location offered
- Student will receive ADA credit applied to housing bill
- Ineligible to waitlist or room swap
- Provided ability to pull in others to their ADA location

OR

DECLINE

- Stay in homesteaded location
- Go through traditional housing selection
- Student will be financially responsible for selected housing assignment
- Eligible to join waitlists and room swaps

ADA PULL IN

Housing cannot guarantee the ability to pull in friends when a student accepts their ADA offer. Housing will share when this is possible and let the student know when we will need confirmation from students.

If provided the opportunity, who would you like to pull into your unit?

Housing will need their consent to be placed.

Remember to communicate your plan with your friends in advance!
