A BILL TO BE ENTITLED: Alternative Break Base Cost

An act to provide for the SGA of HPU to provide funding for *Alpha Phi Omega* in the amount of \$15471.00 to assist with the cost of Brothers and 1 advisor to Costa Rica on October 17-25. Providing for a repeal of all conflicting laws and a savings clause, providing for an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Student Government Association of High Point University:

SECTION 1: Alpha Phi Omega is a service fraternity that focuses on Leadership, Friendship, and Service.

SECTION 2: We are proposing this bill to provide funding for 20 volunteers to travel and stay in Costa Rica for the duration of Fall Break in 2015. The money requested in this bill is strictly to cover the base cost of volunteering with Strong Missions.

SECTION 3: Providing transportation in Costa Rica via Strong Missions by bus. (Kilometers unknown)

SECTION 4: Jody Bowman is our trip advisor, we are fundraising, will have student contribution, and will use \$1,000 budgeted by the chapter.

SECTION 5: BREAKDOWN OF EXPENSES

Housing: \$1200.00

We are staying in the cheapest housing option possible provided by Strong Missions in Costa Rica. This cost includes 6 nights for all 20 people. We will have dorm style rooms with separation by sex.

Transportation: \$2600.00

This price includes all transportation in Costa Rica via buses. Our transportation needs will consist of airport pickup/drop off, trips to the local feeding programs, cultural experiences and construction sites.

Miscellaneous: \$15201.00

Base cost of \$10,000 total. This covers construction material cost, a fixed donation to support the feeding program and funding for staff and strong missions volunteers. The \$500 per person base cost is non-negotiable with Strong Missions. \$3,441 Will go towards our group cultural experiences including trips to Cahuita, Poas, La Paz, and the Bri Bri Village. \$1,760 covers the cost of food at the mission. Students and the advisor will pay out of pocket for food off of the mission site.

SUB TOTAL: \$19001.00

Deductions: -\$3530.00

Students and advisor will contribute \$2,530 toward cultural experiences and additional food costs. | The chapter has \$1,000 in budget to contribute.
