WELCOME TO HIGH POINT UNIVERSITY! This list of suggested items has been developed to help you organize and pack for residential living at High Point University this summer. Some of the items included in the list are optional. Items that are considered essential are marked with an asterisk (*).

APPLIANCES:

- Desk lamp
- Extension cords and adapters (power strip)*
- Alarm clock*
- Iron
- George Foreman Grill, etc. (Anything with a coil burner is not allowed, no toasters or toaster ovens)
- Radio, stereo, television
- Coffee maker
- Hair dryer, curling iron, etc.

LINENS AND TOWELS:

- Bed sheets—2 sets (regular full-size, both fitted and flat)*
- Pillow and pillowcases*
- Blankets*
- Bedspread or comforter*
- Towels and washcloths*
- Mattress cover

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, shampoo, etc.)*
- Toilet paper*

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Black coax cable cord
- Ethernet cable
- First Aid Kit (aspirin, band-aids, etc.)*
- Laundry basket or bag*
- Small vacuum cleaner*
- Clothes hangers*
- Paper products (paper towels, cups, plates, etc.)
- Safe or lockbox for valuables
- Flashlight and batteries
- Cleaning products*
- Basic school supplies (scissors, stapler, pens, paper, etc.)*

AMENITIES PROVIDED:

- Desk
- Desk chair
- Regular full-size mattress
- Garbage can
- Recycling can
- Refrigerator in each room
- Microwave in each room
- Shower curtains are not needed in Caffey Hall
